1 INTRODUCTION

Following the regional IGAs' actions of the support and implementation of transnational pilots aiming at supporting value chain innovation (WPT3) and establishment of transnational networks of innovations stakeholders as the kick-off activity to develop transregional innovation networks and agendas (WPT4) in selected industrial sectors (WPT4), the main activity of the sectoral partner duo is to contribute to the project output O.T4.1 Thematic industrial innovation roadmaps (TIIR).

2.3 Summary of discussions

The main outcome of the discussion held both online and onsite should be seen as the urgent need to set up two streams of actions. Namely, one – that highlights the collaborative opportunities of cross-sectoral initiatives to be developed in the form of transnational medtech-biomed observatory. The need to strengthen collaboration of Polish and Italian SMEs and business-support organisations underpins the first stream of actions. The second stream is built around a learning / facilitation action leading to set-up of a competence center, seen as a powerful innovation support center for the med-tech ecosystem in Silesia. Both soft and hard infrastructures should be focused here.
