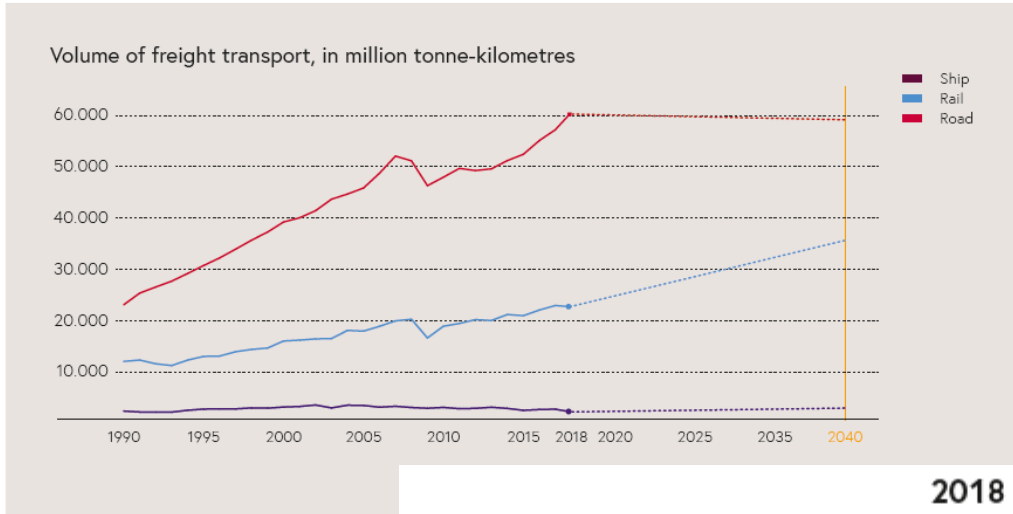

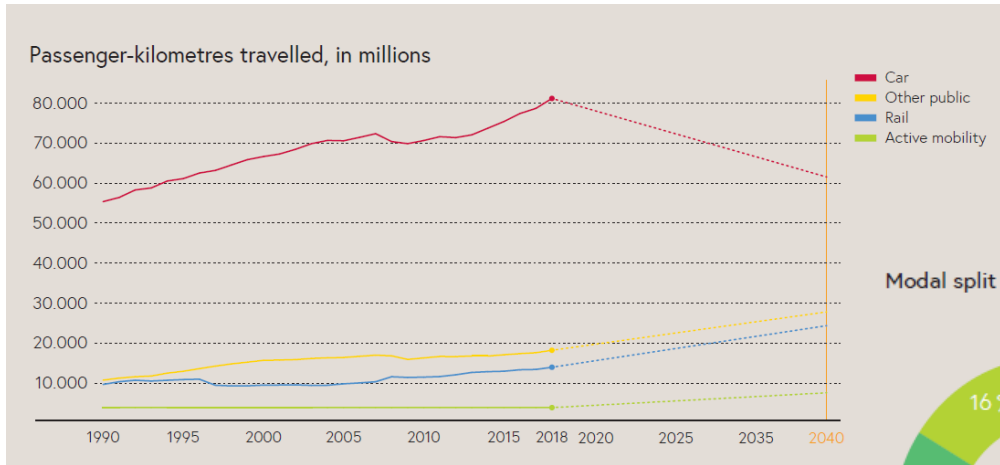
# 1.) Decoupling of GDP-Growth and freight transport



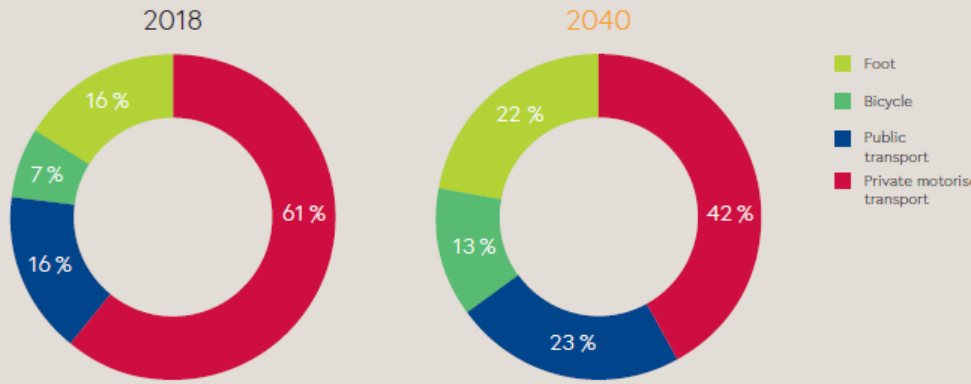

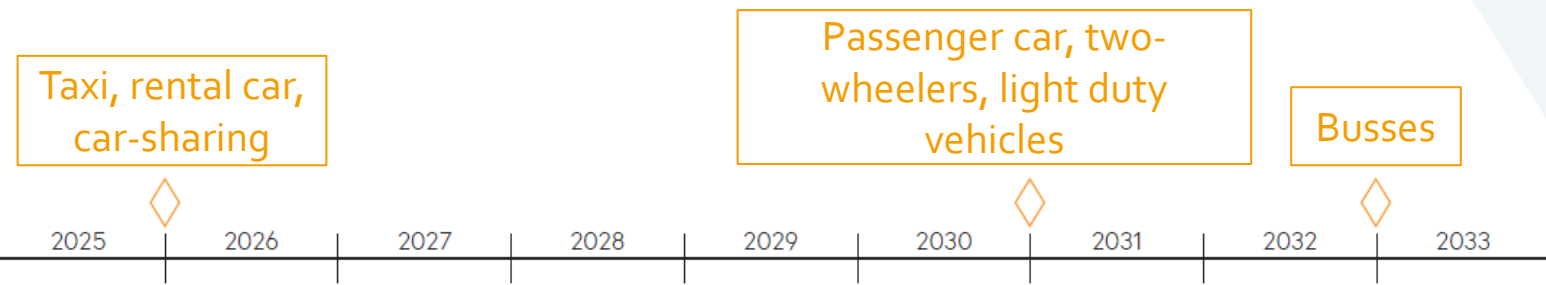


Modal split in passenger transport by mode

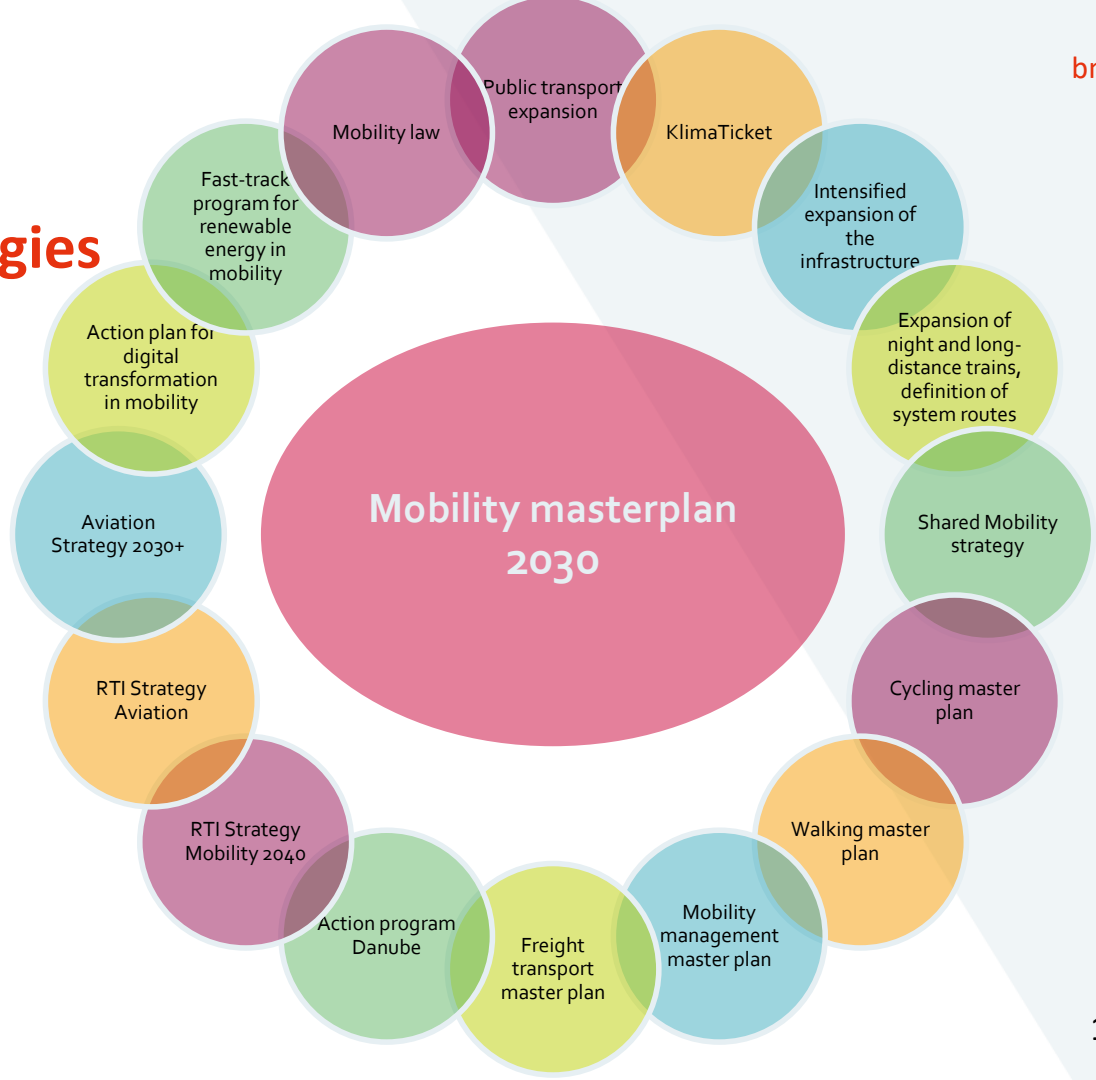

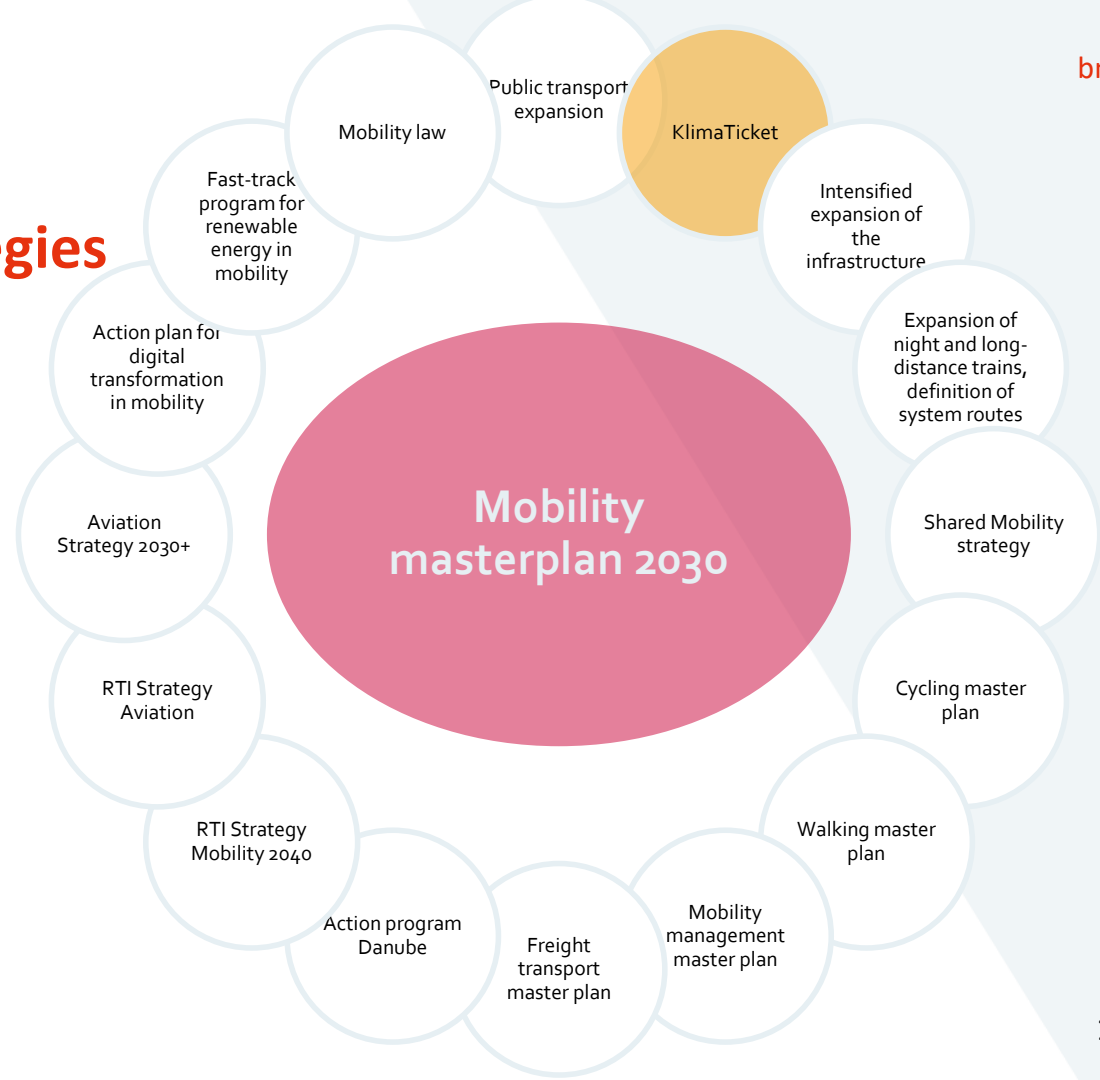
## Monitoring

- Evaluation of target achievement by the Federal Environment Agency
- Annual publication in the NowCast report (first time in summer 2022)
  - Main indicator: CO2 emissions in transport sector
  - Basic indicators (e.g. transport performance, modal split, transport network development)
  - Continuous expansion of indicators

## 26 measures in ten fields of action



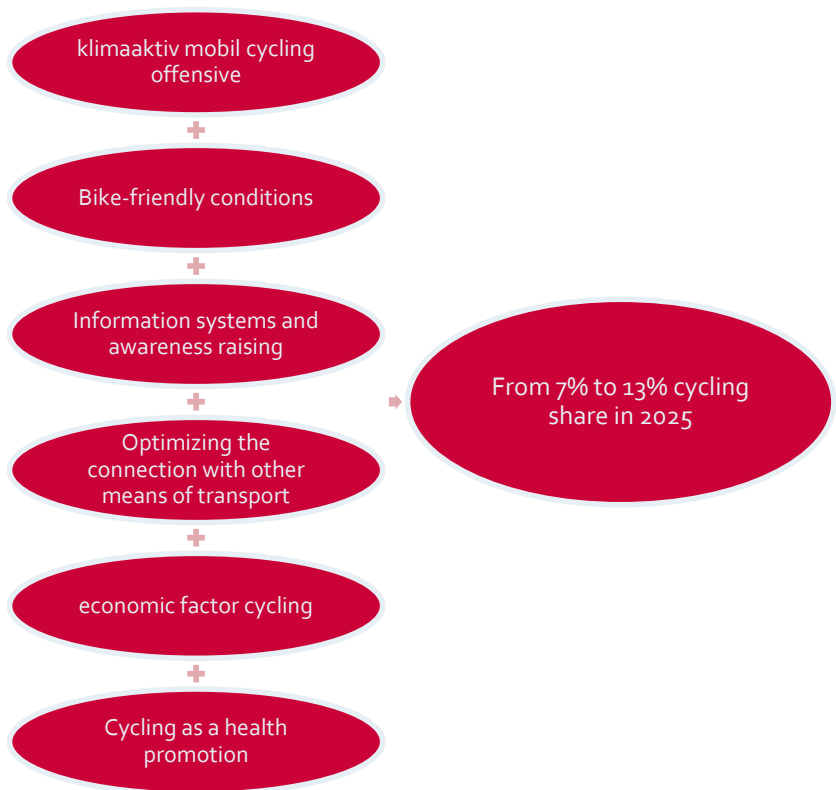
- Strengthened cooperation & coordination

## Masterplan Cycling 2015-2025



- Measure of the climate protection law and the National Health Targets
