



JIKORD is the public-owned company created for the tasks of planning and organizing public transport in South Bohemia region. The region is the second largest in terms of territory but the least densely populated region of the Czech Republic (63 inhabitants per square kilometre). The South Bohemian region is strongly affected by demographic change as the population decreases and ages, leading to changing public transport demands and a need to find new solutions as a loss of population leads to a reduction of public funds available. At present, JIKORD manages 5.8 million kilometres of rail and 20,8 million kilometres of bus transport per year (financed by the South Bohemian Region). The company will contribute to Regiamobil with its expertise, experience and national and European network. will be involved in all project activities, including some of the transnational events to share further insights in the region's transport planning experiences. Though the regional public authority (South Bohemia region) has outsourced all transport-related competences to JIKORD, the political leadership of the regional self-government will remain closely involved in RegiaMobil activities. JIKORD has been tasked to coordinate and order public transport in the South Bohemian region and does not perform any market activities on its own.
