How to get to the venue from the airport

By Public Transport (1h 10min)

Take train S7 (End of Line: Laa/Thaya or Wolkersdorf) or City Airport Train (14,90€) until Wien Mitte/Landstraße (23min, 4,30€). Change then into metro U4 (end of line: Hütteldorf) and get off at the end station Hütteldorf. From there it is either a 12-minute walk or 3 bus stops with 49A, 50A, 450 or 451 to Wolfersberggasse. Opposite is the entrance of the Europahaus. (timetable information: www.wienerlinien.at)

By Taxi/Car (45min)

How to get to the venue from the central train station

By Public Transport (22min)

Take the train S80 (End of Line: Hütteldorf) until the end station. From there it is either a 12-minute walk or 3 bus stops with 49A, 50A, 450 or 451 to Wolfersberggasse. Opposite is the entrance of the Europahaus. (timetable information: <u>www.wienerlinien.at</u>)
