Thuringia's Ohratalbahn ready to resume rail freight services



A feeder line in central Thuringia (DE) is expected to be back in operation after its decommissioning in 2013. As a result of a pilot action of the Interreg Central Europe project REIF, in recent months the line had been cleared of vegetation, tracks were reinforced where necessary, and all bridges have been tested for their load capacity. A stretch of 18 kilometers between Ohrdruf and Gotha, where the line feeds into the main rail network, is now ready for railway transportation. Once the final permits are available, timber transports will be launched, effectively reducing the number of trucks on Thuringia's roads.

Malopolska Regional Development Agency (MARR SA), founded in 1993, one of the greatest institutions of this type in Poland, focuses on important actions leading to positive changes in the regional environment. MARR SA plays a vital role as a tool of the self-government of the voivodeship.

Regarding Rail4Regions, MARR's primary objective relies on identifying and analysing the regional potential of rail freight transport in relation to local economic structure. The agency aims for a new impact on the process of decision-making, sensitivity for environment protection and a new opening for rail networks on the regional and transnational size.
