<u>Szeged Transport Company (SZKT)</u>'s main role in the Interreg CE4CE project is carrying out two pilot actions: replacement of trolleybus switches and developing a universal model for the replacement of the malfunctioning door opening and closing control mechanism of Tatra tram vehicles.
