Transforming Abandoned Wells for Geothermal Energy Production



TRANSGEO is a regional development project that aims to explore the potential for producing sustainable geothermal energy from abandoned oil and gas wells in Central Europe. TRANSGEO is funded through April 2026 with a budget of 2.61 million Euros.

























The fossil fuels industry is declining in central Europe and leaves behind countless gas and oil wells.

The TRANSGEO project is turning this environmental problem into an opportunity, by investigating the potential of abandoned infrastructures for producing and storing green geothermal energy.

The partnership is developing a Transnational Strategy and Action Plan to give a second life to the wells and is testing their repurposing potential in local pilot actions.
