



## Making tourism accessible to all

Accessible tourism allows people with disabilities to travel independently. But there is still often a lack of awareness for their needs, especially in rural areas. The CE-Spaces4All project connects public authorities, the tourism sector and people with disabilities to improve governance for a more accessible tourism. The partners develop a digital tool for mapping barriers in three rural regions and provide these with a joint strategy and local action plans to better integrate accessibility considerations in territorial planning.
