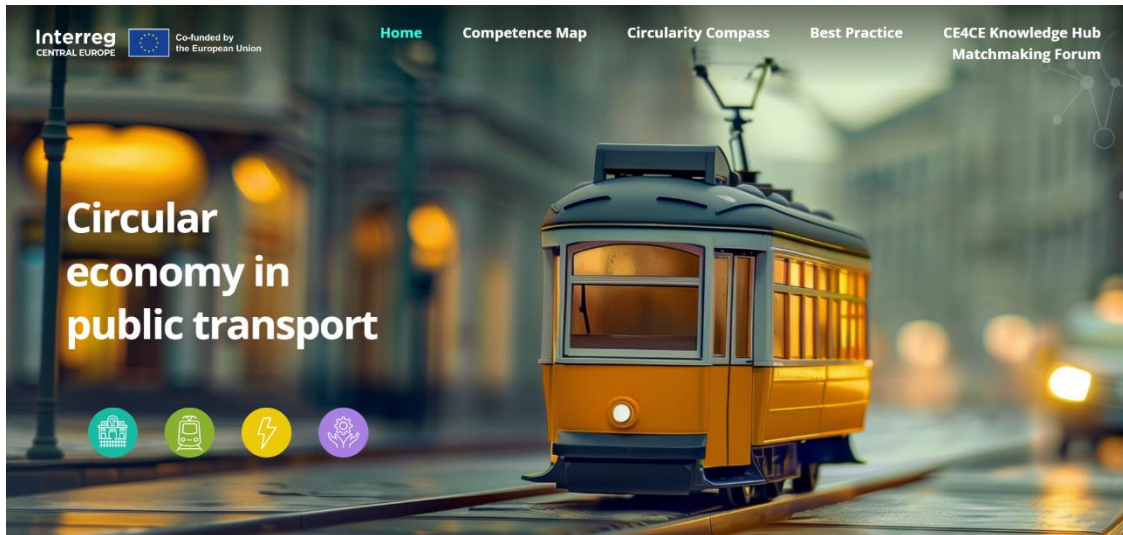
Circularity Compass - an innovative tool for public transport stakeholders
