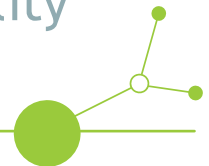

The Green LaMiS project aims to develop a transnational solution to make the last mile of home social services delivery more sustainable in medium to small-sized cities in Central Europe. Currently, these services, provided by Social Enterprises (SEs) on behalf of Local Authorities (LAs), are often inefficient and contribute to high CO2 emissions, traffic congestion, and poor connectivity between urban areas and surrounding regions.

The project aims at creating a common strategy and action plan using an innovative methodological tool that calculates the Carbon Footprint and considers territorial and service characteristics.

To ensure long-term impact, capacity-building activities will be conducted to equip LAs and SEs with the skills to monitor and reduce CO2 emissions in urban social mobility. The findings will be integrated into existing green urban mobility plans to support future improvements.

On that premises, we, the undersigned partners and associated partners of the Green LaMiS project, hereby acknowledge the critical need to enhance the sustainability of urban mobility for social enterprises in medium to small-sized cities across Central Europe.

Recognizing the importance of this initiative, we collectively commit to the following actions:

- ✓ Collaboration and Coordination: We pledge to work collaboratively, utilizing shared tools and methodologies to ensure a unified approach. This includes the implementation of pilot actions that are guided by common methodological guidelines.

- ✓ Improvement of Urban Mobility for Social Enterprises and for the cities overall: We are committed to improving urban mobility in a sustainable manner. This includes promoting the use of eco-friendly transportation options for SE and enhancing the overall mobility infrastructure.
- ✓ Dissemination of Best Practices: We will actively work to spread best practices and project results across Central European cities. This will involve sharing our findings, successes, and lessons learned with other cities and stakeholders to promote wider adoption of sustainable mobility solutions.

By signing this agreement, we affirm our dedication to these principles and our commitment to working together towards a more sustainable future for urban mobility in Central Europe.


