The CONE project aims to establish 5 urban Living Labs to apply nature-based solutions as a cross-sectoral, more digitally-driven and democratic approach to climate change mitigation and adaptation. The partners design and test new participatory and digitally driven processes that support the application of nature-based solutions in five urban pilot areas. Learnings from these urban living labs are then evaluated and inform a new transnational strategy for the introduction of urban greening plans.
