






KARAVANKE MOUNTAINS

In the Western Karavanke mountains there are meadows with numerous **daffodils** (*Narcissus poeticus* subsp. *radiiflorus*).

In Slovenia daffodil is **not an endangered species**, but it is nevertheless **protected by the law** and at the same time very **attractive** to people.

Due to **high biodiversity**, daffodil meadows are also of great importance for **nature conservation**.

52 habitat types were mapped in various combinations.



Many **protected** plant species, such as

common arnica (*Arnica montana*),

Zois violet (*Viola zoysii*),

Zois bellflower (*Campanula zoysii*),

Clusi's gentian (*Gentiana clusii*),

primrose (*Primula auricula*),

Carniolan lily (*Lilium carniolicum*),

common butterwort (*Pinguicula vulgaris*)


alpine butterwort (*Pinguicula alpina*),

and

numerous orchids (*Orchidaceae*).




76 species of butterflies (10 of them **protected) were listed**

Appropriate agricultural management of the meadows is crucial to preserve daffodils whose abundance have been **declining** for decades.

We observe two perspectives:

as agricultural activity **modernizes and adapts to modern trends and techniques**, many daffodil meadows are subject to the pressures of these changes.

On the other hand, agriculture is difficult due to steep slopes, high altitude, poor accessibility and a **general decrease in interest in farming** by young people, causing extensively cultivated mountain meadows to become **overgrown**.



Save the Daffodils Program

The local Development Agency and the Municipality of Jesenice created a multi-year program in 2016 called "**Preserve Daffodils**", which set out:

- measures for the appropriate agricultural treatment of meadows with daffodils and
- provides financial compensation for landowners who comply with these measures.

The program is based on the **voluntary participation** of owners.

The owners can include any area of land, where they will ensure **appropriate agricultural cultivation**.

The program determines **the dates** when mowing can begin and **other agricultural practices** that benefit daffodils (e.g. fertilization only with organic fertilizers). Over time, it was discovered that the key factor in these meadows was **late mowing**, because it enables daffodil to fill the bulb with nutrients for early spring growth and flowering.

The Development Agency carries out at least one **supervisory inspection** on all areas involved per year.

Monitoring of the number of blooming daffodils has been established at **ten poligones** of 12.6sqm, starting in 2000.

The number of flowers is counted at these poligones every year during the flowering period (in may)

Monitoring

The poligones were selected taking into account the following criteries:

- area with subsidy,
- area with no subsidy,
- agricultural intervention already carried out (e.g. land leveling),
- omission of mowing.


Within the entire monitoring period, climatological indicators such as **temperature and precipitation** are also monitored.




Total number of flowers






Abandonment of mowing 2013




Subsidy after land leveling (melioration) in 2019






No subsidy





From 2024 one of the goals of the ReCo project was also to propagate the daffodils using **seeds** (on testing plots and in „artificial“ conditions) With the aim of a faster „return“ of daffodils.

Two sowing methods: seeds **covered** with humus and **not covered** with humus





6 : 64

free seeds : covered seeds (april 2025)



Germination on the field was very successful
(may 2025)





First findings (with low statistical probability)

- **High variability of the number** of flowers per year due to weather conditions: problem are high temperatures in early spring time and frosts that follows (2024, 2025).
- **Good recovery** after land melioration with proper management following.
- Great influence of **light** conditions.
- Significantly better germination of seeds **covered with humus**.



Further activities

The **ReCo project Regional Restoration plan (D.3.2.2)**) was prepared in 2024.

Main focuses of the program are:

- **Agriculture:** *Save the daffodil* program continues and is being upgraded, maintaining agriculture activities,...
- **Nature conservation:** monitoring, renaturation, raising awareness,..
- **Tourism and local community:** reduction of tourism impact, preventing overtourism, financing,...
