DEEP GEOTHERMAL ENERGY by DEEEP (cooperation Joint Venture of OMV and Wien Energie „Vienna Energy“) <https://www.deeep.at/>


Description:

The municipality of Vienna has committed to stop heating with gas and oil by 2030, by promoting and implementing heating with deep geothermal energy in Vienna. Their goal is to produce 200 MW and to provide 200.000 households with sustainable heat in Vienna. OMV (Austria's biggest oil and gas company) and Wien Energie (Vienna's biggest heat and electricity production company) founded a Joint Venture to plan and build deep geothermal plants. The plant in Seestadt (beyond Danube) is the first pilot in Vienna. They drilled 3 wells down to approximately 3.000 m in 2025, accessing water of the Aderklaaer Konglomerat: 1 well for hot water production, 1 for reinjection (4 kilometres away from the production well), and 1 test well. They are currently conducting the first tests.

Costs to date are approximately 90 Million €. In the end 20.000 households should be supplied with heat. In total, seven geothermal plants are planned.

On the tour we will learn about the 3 drilled wells and the plans for the future operation. There is an extensive Information Center on the construction site where the expert excursion will be led by two technical project managers.

SHALLOW GEOTHERMAL ENERGY (cooperation of Beyond Carbon Energy Holding and TERRA Umwelttechnik)


Description:

The site of the Grüner Prater shallow geothermal wells is adjacent to the University of Economics Prater (local recreation area) and Krieau (horse trotting track). To the East of trotting track, there is a construction site for 2 large apartment buildings (several hundred apartments). To supply these buildings with heating and cooling, the developers have drilled 9 groundwater wells (approximately 10 m deep), and heat pumps will be added.

A field of approximately 300 shallow wells („Erdwärmesondenfeld“) is planned for heating the two apartment buildings.

We will have a tour with engineers of the wells, seeing the wells and heat pumps.
