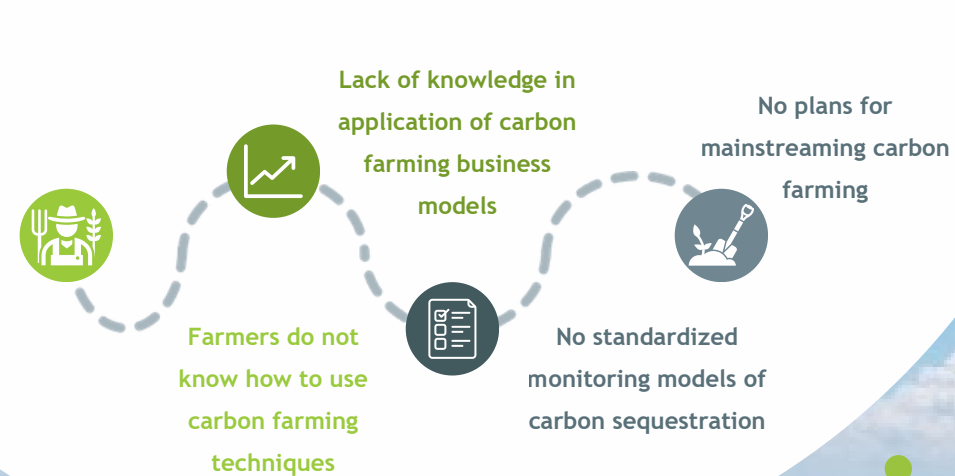

Pilot testing of carbon farming techniques

Testing different techniques, to create a baseline transnational report for carbon farming solutions.

Guide for implementation of carbon farming techniques in Central Europe to minimize CO₂ and improve soil quality

Pilot testing of carbon farming business models

Testing business models across five stakeholder groups, followed by a peer review to create a comprehensive baseline model.
